**Available Hospital Beds – DHS Hospitals<sup>1</sup>/ED Volume/Census**

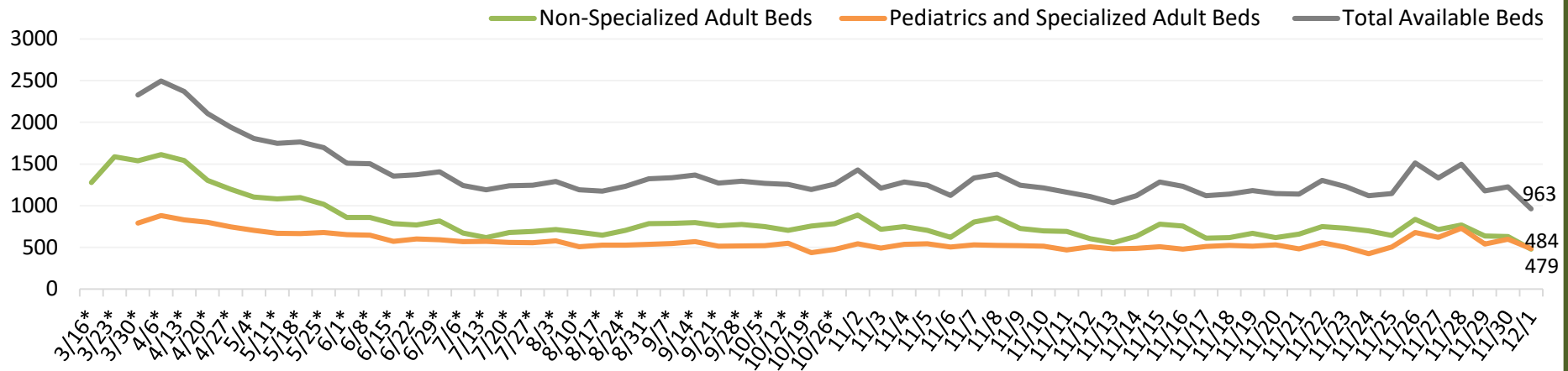

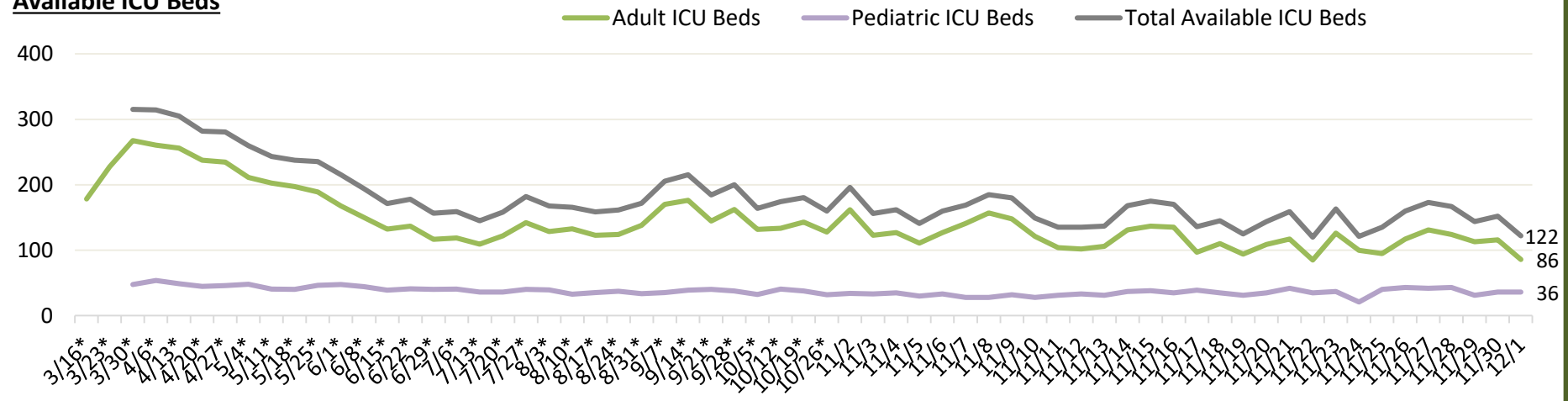

## Available ICU Beds



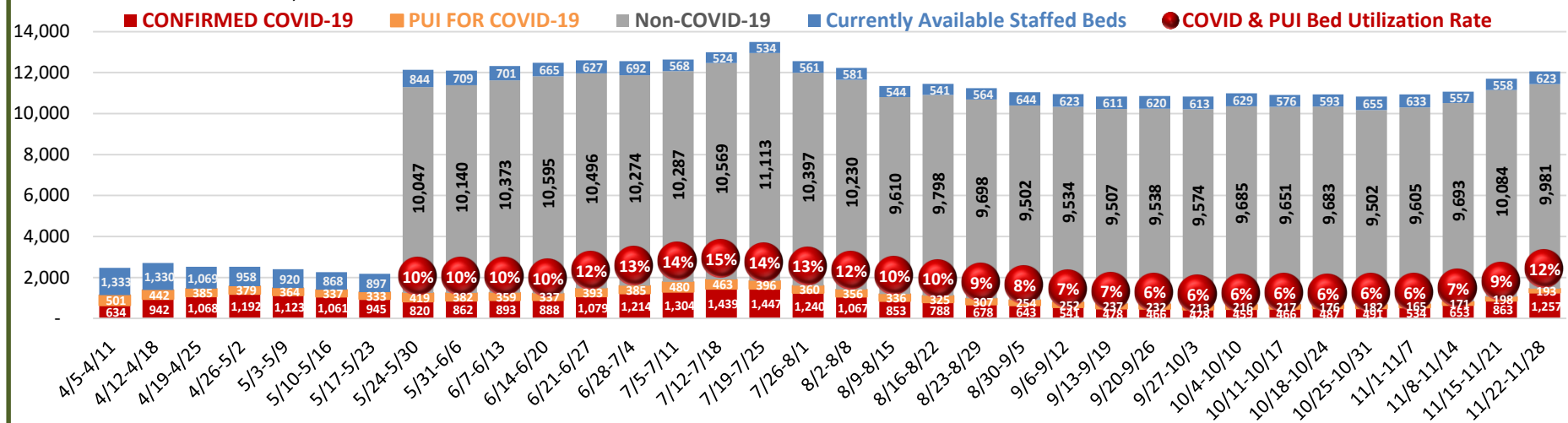

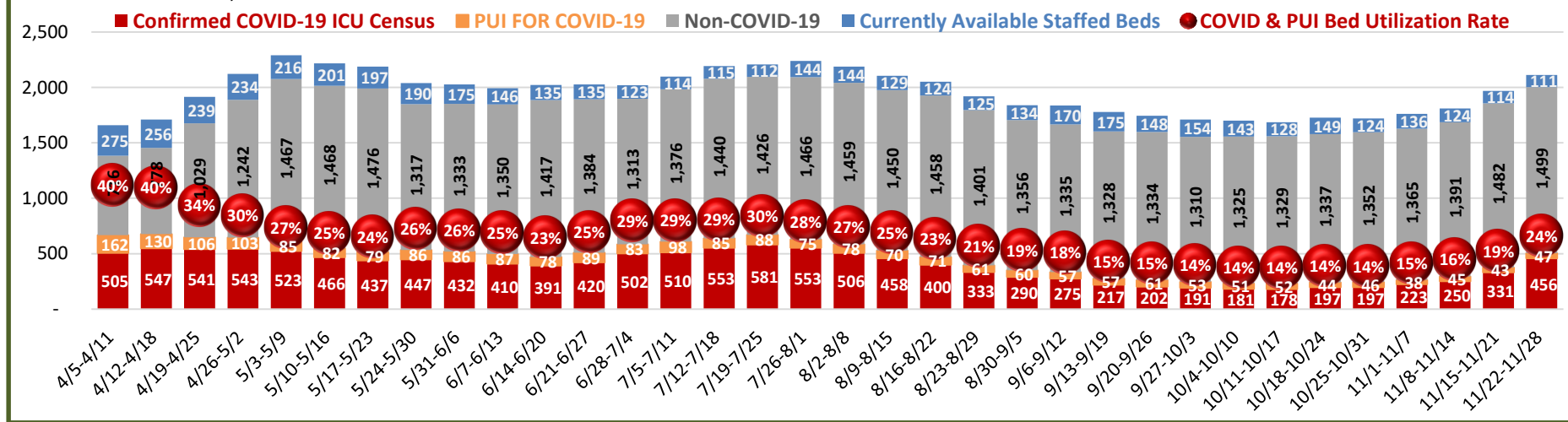
### Average Daily Non-ICU (Med/Surg/SDU/Telemetry) Census

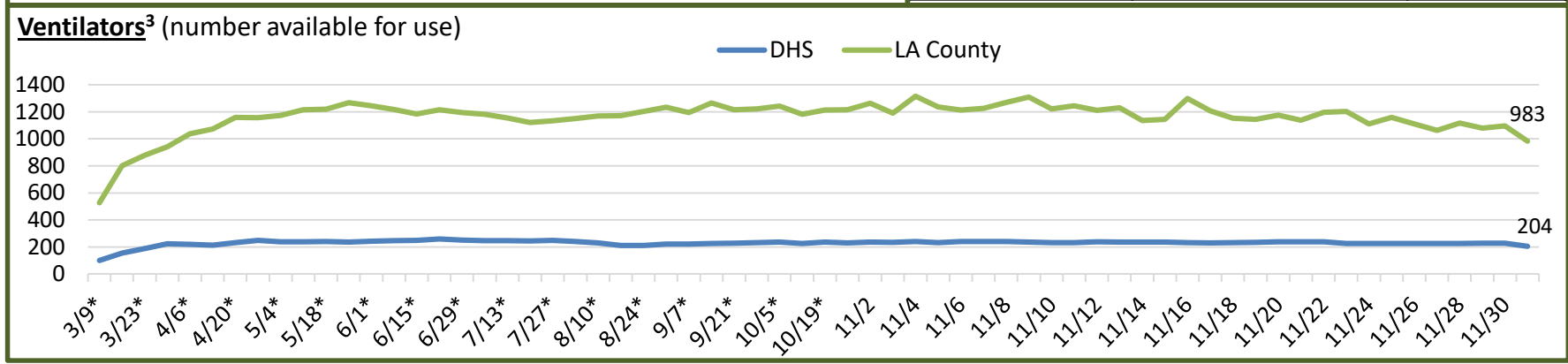

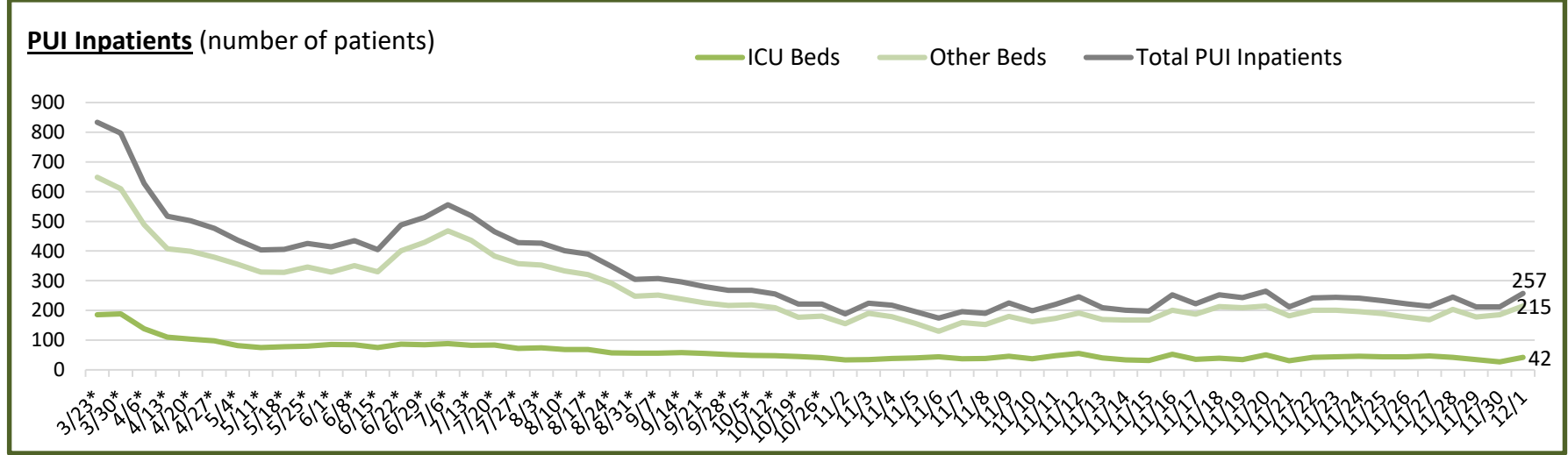
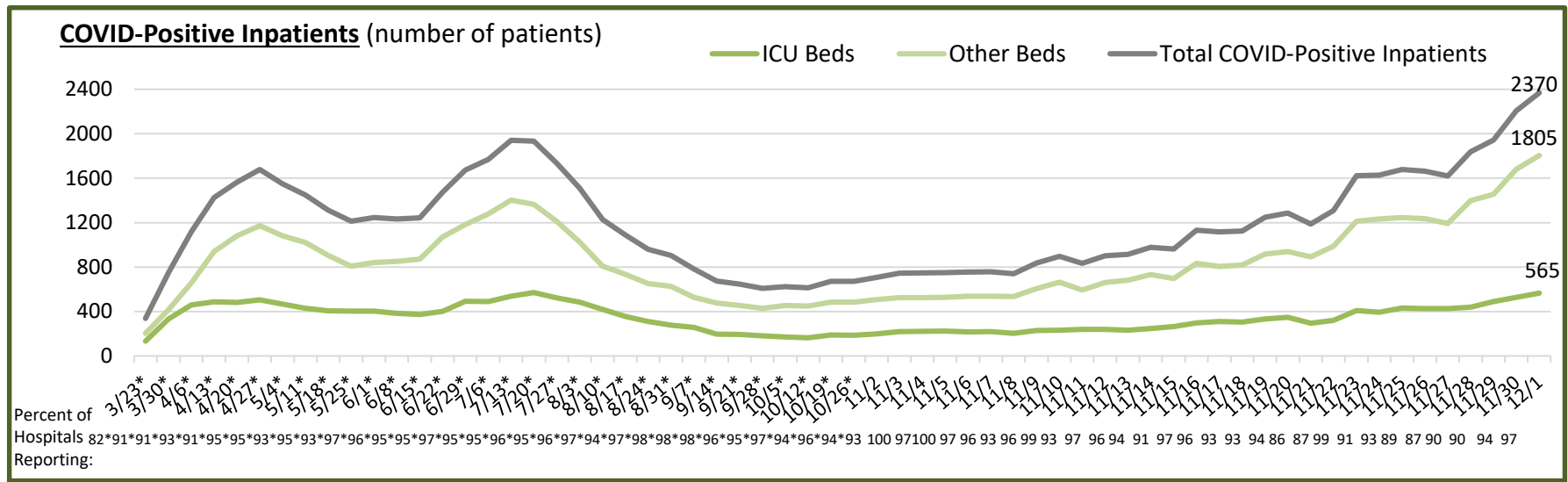
**DHS<sup>1</sup> Hospitalized Patients by COVID Status**

**LA County<sup>1</sup> Hospitalized Patients by COVID Status**

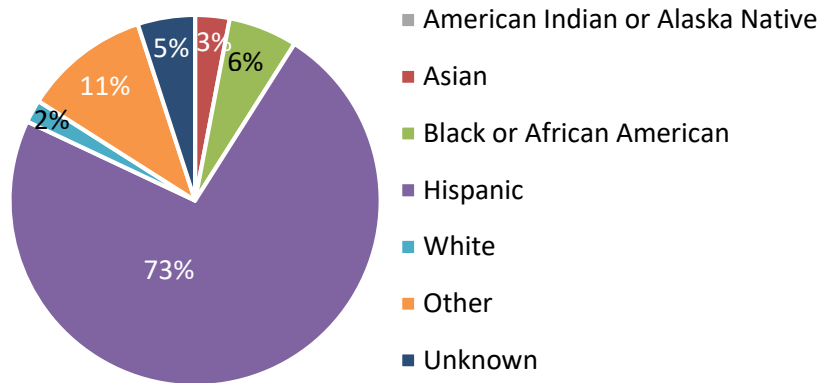

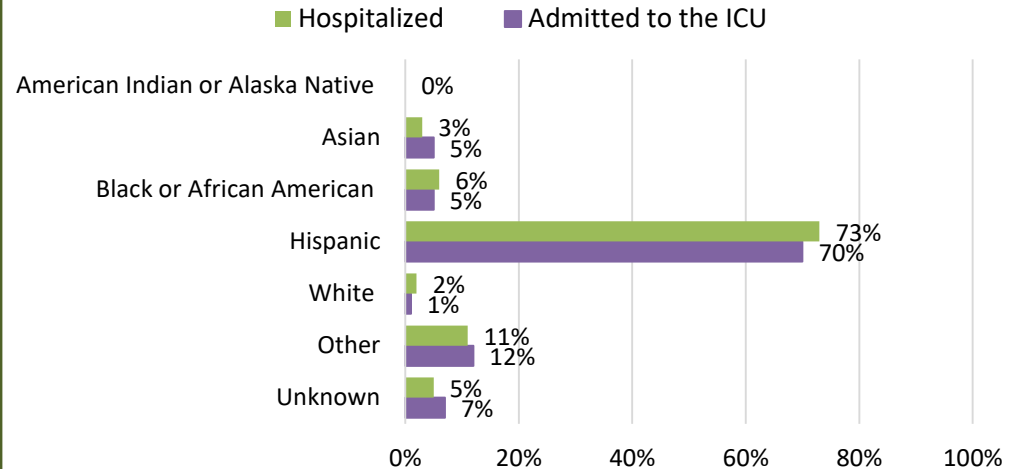

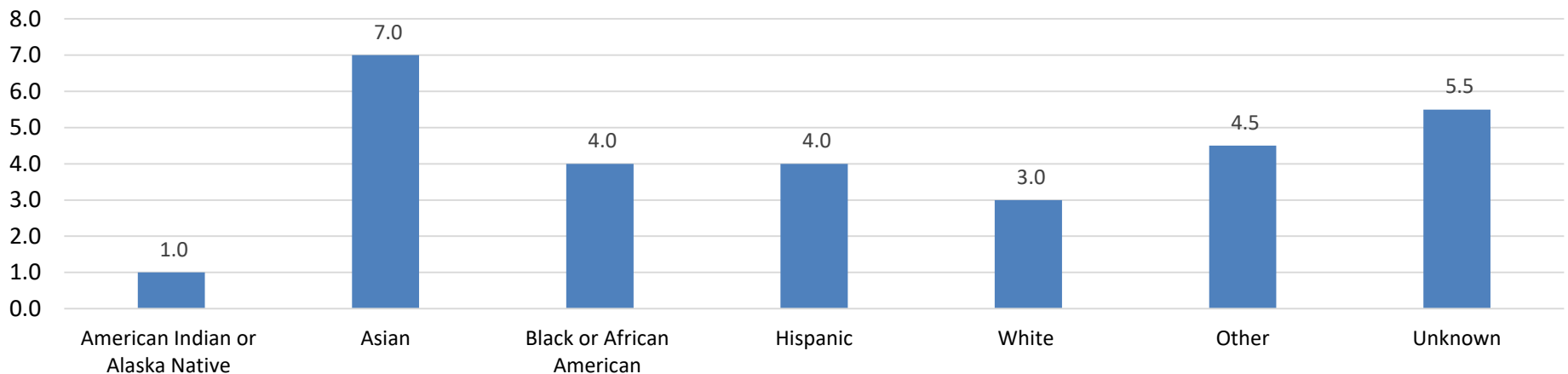
**COVID Cases Hospitalized by Race/Ethnicity** (% of patients)

**Length of Stay for Hospitalized COVID Positive Patients Who Have Been Discharged, by Race/Ethnicity<sup>2</sup>** (# of days)



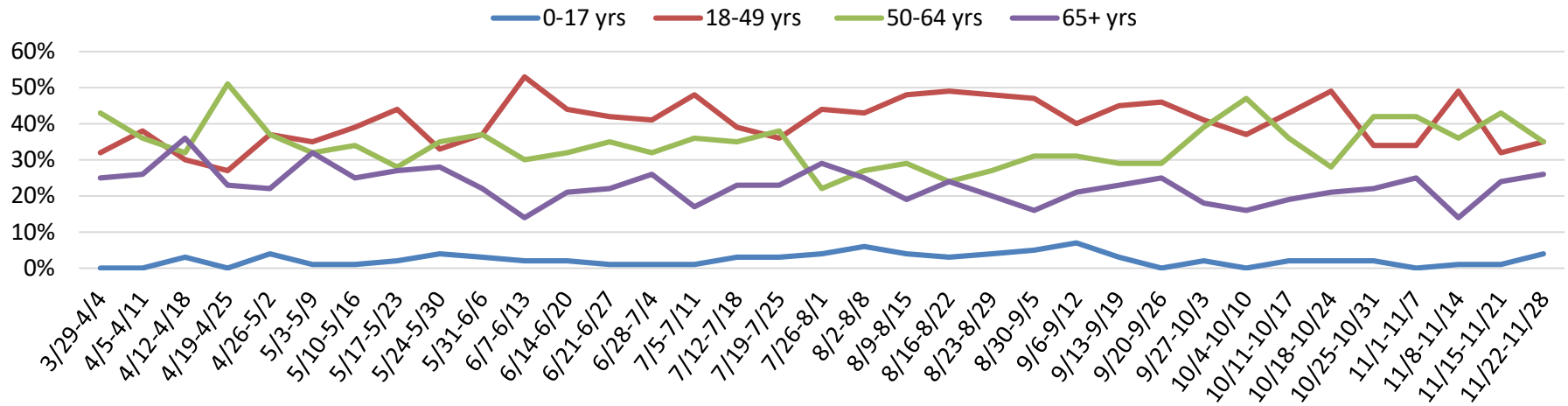

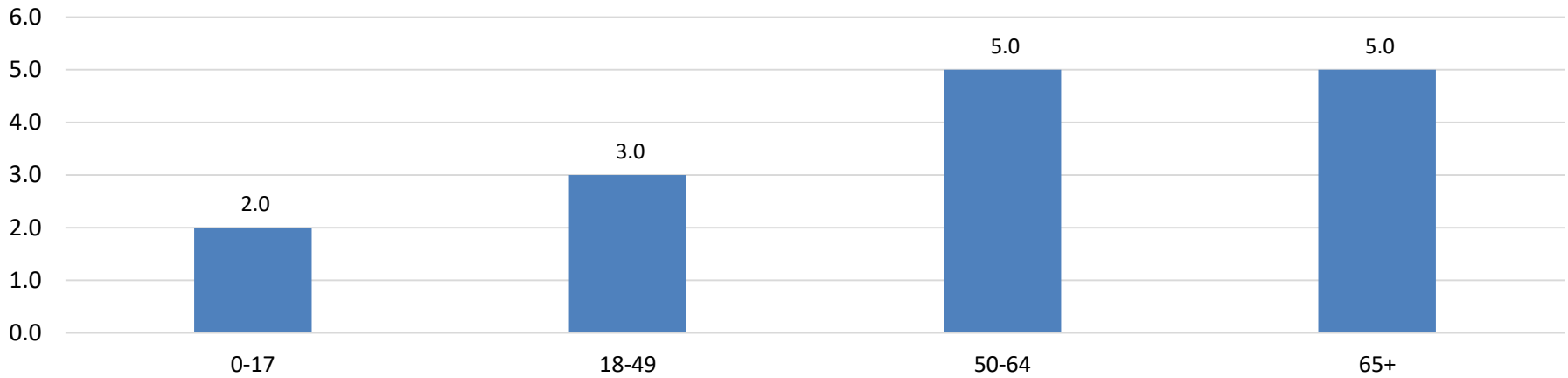
**DHS COVID Demographics by Age<sup>1</sup>**
